- Building blocks for regional solutions
- Broad and not yet site specific

Permitting Management Actions

- MA-054_ Develop regional and river-corridor conservation plans, or expand existing regional conservation plans (such as regional Habitat Conservation Plans and Natural Community Conservation Plans) to provide a more efficient and effective regulatory approval process for flood projects.
- MA-055_ Develop regional advance mitigation strategies and networks of mitigation banks to meet the needs of flood and other public infrastructure projects.

Permitting Category Management Actions

- MA-056_Develop regional permitting approaches such as corridor management strategies (CMS).


