






# Revisions to Regional Conditions and CVFPP Document Organization

## Review Planning Definitions

- **Problems and Opportunities**
  - Describe the basic problems or undesirable conditions
  - Outline how we could contribute to other needs/benefits while addressing the identified problems
- **Goals** – Describe the broad and enduring values, direction or desired conditions we want to achieve
- **Objectives** – Specify what we want to accomplish with the CVFPP
- **Principles** – Define how we go about doing business (things we want to do, or avoid doing, as we develop and implement the CVFPP)

## Summary of Your Input

- About 200 comments received
  - The majority of comments were refinements or additions to the contributing factors
  - It was suggested that climate change is a driver for almost all of the problem statements
  - Other comments touched upon topics such as
    - Public perception of flood risk (Information and Education)
    - Liability, responsibility, and agency coordination (Policy and Institutional)
    - Emergency preparedness and response (Flood Risk)
- Comments also led to refinement of draft CVFPP goals

- Initial discussions on objectives will provide focus to the next phase of the planning process -> identification of Management Actions
- Objectives will be revisited and refined as we move forward – this is an iterative process
