The Delta Stewardship Council's Delta Science Program, the University of California, Davis Center for Aquatic Biology & Aquaculture, and the University of California, Davis Center for Watershed Sciences will present a free day-long seminar, titled "[Meeting Nature Halfway on a Floodplain – The Yolo Bypass as a Reconciled Ecosystem](#)," December 9 in Davis that is open to the public. The seminar brings together several of the key investigators — engineers, ecologists, and economists — for a public discussion about how farming and floods might be reconciled with fish and fowl.

DWR opens proposed SWP supply contract amendments to public

[DWR and the State Water Project \(SWP\) Contractors will negotiate proposed amendments to the SWP water supply contracts between DWR and the SWP Contractors.](#) The proposed amendments will address allocation and payment of certain planning costs, financing of the implementation, and operation and maintenance of certain aspects of the proposed Bay Delta Conservation Plan (BDCP), if it is approved. The public may attend and observe the negotiations and provide comments to DWR at the end of each negotiation session. The initial session is December 10 in Sacramento.
